It's been a full year since the launch of Avondale Radio - Strathaven and District's community radio station.

It has been great for our Church to have have had the opportunity to be part of this and Crossbeats was broadcast for the first time in the very first week of the station. Now, 52 shows later, the team of Angus and Murray is being increased to include, Calum and Liz, Chris Macrae and Graeme Lacey.

We can't underestimate the opportunity and impact of this show.

As you will know it's centred on the idea of exploring the lyrics, meaning and motivation of contemporary Christian artists. Over the last year we have had the opportunity to introduce the listening public to many artists - in genres like rock, blues pop, Indie, country. The only restrictions we've placed on ourselves is that the music is contemporary and has something to say about the Christian faith.

Throughout we have been really encouraged by the feedback from the station management and others of the 34 or so Avondale radio presenters, about the quality of what we are doing. Listeners are seriously impressed that there is Christian music out there that they can relate to.

Every week we get to talk about God, about Jesus and about what we as a Christian community are up to in the town. What could be better than that?
