Anyone dealing with potentially vulnerable individuals (children, the elderly, disabled or mentally vulnerable) really requires training in order to understand their responsibilities as church volunteer or worker. We have arranged in house training for all involved in youth and children's work, pastoral visiting and any other interested parties. Your safeguarding certification may require updating.
